

# Open Call for Applications Training Program for Community Organizers

## About the Program

This program is designed to train and support local community organizers living in Prague who have ideas that promote intercultural openness, connect communities, and support active citizenship or socially beneficial goals (e.g., environmental protection, support of vulnerable groups, etc.).

The program will equip participants with essential skills and knowledge to bring their ideas to life. It also aims to foster a vibrant network of like-minded individuals who can collaborate and support one another in making a positive impact.

## **Key Program Activities**

#### Training (March-April 2025)

Participants will receive training on essential topics such as community organizing, fundraising, and intercultural communication. These sessions will foster peer-to-peer learning, allowing participants to share experiences and build networks with other community organizers.

### **Wini-Project Implementation (April – May 2025)**

Participants can apply for a micro-grant (5,000 – 7,000 CZK) to implement their mini-projects, putting their newly acquired skills and knowledge into practice.

### 출 Language Café (4 Sessions)

Informal sessions designed to facilitate connection, discussion, and Czech language practice, focusing on key words and concepts relevant to community activities.

### Vetworking Event (March 26, 2025, 17:30 – 20:00)

Participants will present their ideas at an Open Mic session, attended by representatives from various institutions and organizations, providing visibility and collaboration opportunities.


### Mentoring (4 Hours per Participant)

Each participant will receive personalized support from a mentor on the MigAct team.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- **Migration Background:** Must have a migration background and currently reside in Prague.
- Age Requirement: 18 years or older.
- English Proficiency: Advanced English skills (program conducted in English).
- **Community Engagement Experience (Preferred):** Prior experience in community engagement or civic participation is desirable.
- **Project Proposal:** Applicants must submit a proposal for a bridging project fostering connections between Czechs and foreigners within local civil society. The project should focus on civic or political engagement and will be developed and implemented as part of the program.
- **Commitment:** Full participation in all program activities is mandatory.


