Are you passionate about civic life in Prague? Whether you are mobilizing neighbors, advocating for local change, or creating spaces for public engagement, we want to help you grow and connect with other like-minded people.

Join our **Community Organizers Training**—a 40-hour capacity-building journey designed for those ready to deepen their practice and amplify their impact.

About the Program

This initiative supports active community organizers in Prague who want to refine their skills in engaging people around shared issues and building sustainable initiatives. Through this programme, you will:

- ✓ **Sharpen practical skills** in facilitation, communication, and fundraising.
- ✓ **Navigate diversity** by learning to organize effectively across social and cultural differences.
- ✓ **Launch a community organizing activity** with the support of a small mini-grant (approx. 5,000 CZK).
- ✓ **Build a network** of like-minded peers to support your long-term growth.

This Project has been supported by the European Philanthropic Initiative for Migration (EPIM), a collaborative initiative of the Network of European Foundations (NEF). The mini grants are supported by Česka spořitelna a.s.

Key Activities

- 1. Practical Training (40 hours):** A mix of in-person workshops and online peer sessions focused on real-world community organizing skills.
- 2. Community organizing activity (Mini-Grant Support):** Design and run your own community activity between May and September 2026. Participants will refine their idea during the training and receive a small financial support (mini-grant around 5.000 CZK) for implementation.
- 3. Networking Event (Prague):** Showcase your work and connect with local institutions and potential partners.
- 4. Peer Learning and Mentoring Support:** Receive ongoing support and peer learning from the MigAct team.

Who Should Apply?

The program is suitable for people who:

- Are actively involved in civic activities in Prague (e.g. grassroots organizing, community initiatives, neighborhood engagement, etc.).
- Want to strengthen their impact or develop their community organizing practice further.
- Are 18+ and can participate in English
- Please note: active civic engagement is required.

Full participation in all program activities, including training sessions and the implementation of the community organizing activity is mandatory.
